

# 2022 Annual Service Data



## 560 Adults living in Rutland County received healthcare services.

- 83% of all patients served were new to the RCFC!
- 23% of patients served were aged 65+ years
- 52% of patients served reside outside of Rutland City
- Self-identified Gender served 50%M/50% F
- 250 uninsured - 310 under-insured

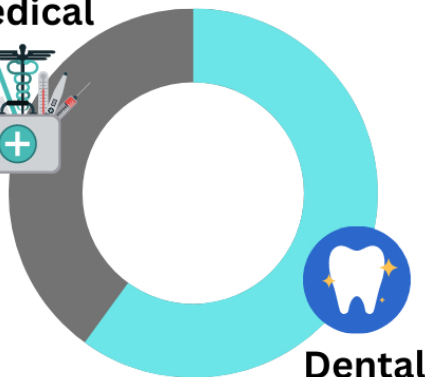
## Volunteers

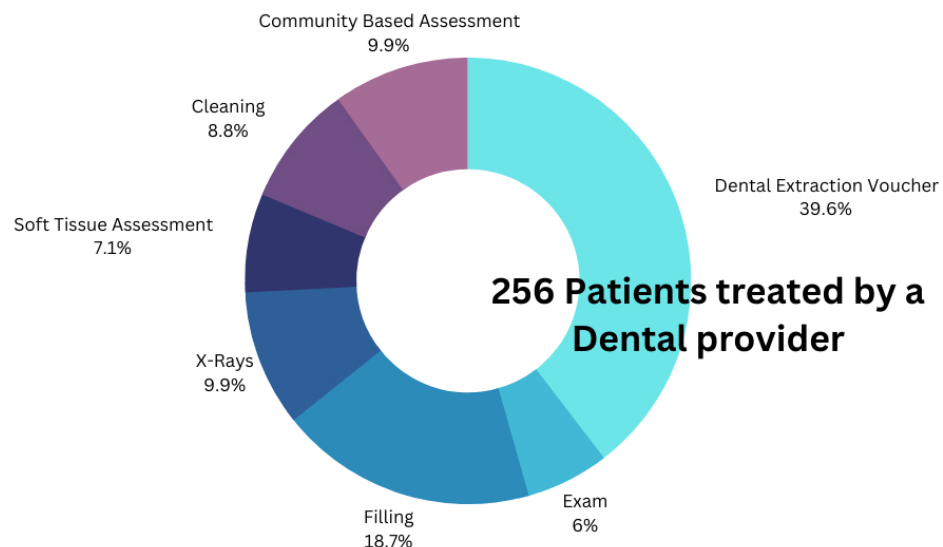
## Health Clinics: 110

- 70 Immunizations provided to adults aged 65+ by the RCFC at a cost of \$ 23,000.00
